A ferry from **Baltimore Pier** will bring you over to Sherkin Island.
The ferry will be running back to back on **Friday** and **Saturday**.

A Late ferry will run on **Thursday** at **11.45pm**
Last ferry on **Friday** is **11.30pm**
Last ferry on **Saturday** is **8.30pm**

On arrival a bus will shuttle your luggage to the festival site, **free of charge**.

It's a rather beautiful 35 minute walk to the festival site from registration.
